In Spring 2015, Council began considering what God is calling us to do and to be in this time and place. This visioning process started with Council members doing a book study on *Living Lutheran: Renewing Your Congregation* by Rev. Dave Daubert.

In January this process continued at the churchwide retreat, where members had a chance to reflect on what God did in scripture and on how that might be guiding us. With much time spent praying, reading Scripture, listening to the Holy Spirit and one another, the Purpose Statement and Guiding Principles were drafted. These were further refined in small groups, by the Leadership Team and at Council.

In looking to the future of Grace Lutheran, the Council is asking the congregation consider and adopt the Purpose Statement and Guiding Principles (on the other side) to help us fulfill how God is asking us to live out our faith.
