

On the first weekend of June, we will celebrate Pentecost, the coming of the Holy Spirit to the early disciples and their community. We recognize it as the birth of the church, celebrating it with the liturgical color of red for fire of the Spirit. This is a time to remember the Spirit is with us still. In this season of growing and life, let our faith be growing and living too. May the blessing of God's word enrich your lives and our life together.





# Kid's Page






Make this heartwarming handprint gift to give your dad or another special man on Father's Day.
