
New schedules for October 2017-September 2018 have been completed and are posted on the bulletin board across from the Fellowship Hall. Copies are available to be picked up.

The day was a gift to us seeing and knowing we made a difference for some kids and gave the families a day that they did not have to plan. I really invite you to hear from some of our members who were there. Let them tell you the experiences they had with the guests and what the day meant to them.

Mike and Mary Arzo of the Amusement Park were so generous. As the day went on and the kids kept having fun, the rides and activities kept being available for all to enjoy well beyond the original offer we had with them. That made the day all the more special because as we got to know the guests and they us, we continued to have fun together.

So just to let you know if you missed out this year, there is a chance to participate in it next year, because the date was already set with the Arzos before this year's day was over. **Mark your** calendar for Saturday September 9th 2018 and join in.



## **People Are People Community Program on Immigration Issues** Wed., Oct. 11 - 6:30 p.m. at Grace

Grace's Council offered our church as a site for a public community forum on immigration issues. The program begins at 6:30 on Wednesday, October 11, with presentations on a comparison of Christianity and Islam by Rev. Dr. Bob Case, the refugee resettlement programs of Samaritas (Lutheran Social Services of Michigan) who is the largest refugee resettlement agency in Michigan and 4th largest in the country by Rev. Dr. Nic Shillack and Sarrah Buagella of Muslims for American Progress in Dearborn. There will be Middle Eastern and Latin American desserts as part of the evening.

The evening's program is being sponsored by ALCU People Power Freedom Cities. Association of Lifelong Learners at ACC, League of Women Voters of Alpena County, People for Social Justice, Northeast Michigan Ministerial Association, Alpena Peace Coalition and Building Bridges to Understanding. It has been included on the calendar for 30 Days of Peace.

## **Public Education Funding in Michigan** Forum at Grace Thursday Nov. 2 at 6:30 p.m.

On Thursday November 2nd, People for Social Justice Education Group is offering a public program on public education funding in Michigan. Craig Thiel of Citizens Research Council will present information on current status of funding in Michigan. The Citizens Research Council was established to bring about sound governmental policy through factual research, is respected for independent, nonpartisan approach and noted for factual, objective issue analysis. A number of area school superintendents have been invited to participate sharing their experiences in their districts. 

Make this sign to hang on your wall as a daily reminder of God's amazing gift of grace.




#### What you need:

- White poster board
- Large wooden letters that spell GRACE
- Painter's tape
- Tempura paint
- Paper plates
- Paintbrushes
- Colored pens or markers

#### What you do:
